re: Returning to Class

Dear Parents and Students,

We are excited to welcome students back onto campus on Monday March 8, 2021. There are a few important things that we would like to share to make this return smooth and successful. We feel like we have good plans in place but I'm sure that there will be some adaptations or changes that will need to be made and we appreciate your patience as we get everything worked out.

March 8-March 11 is not a normal weekly schedule. Since we have a school holiday on March 12, we will skip our normal Monday schedule on March 8. **March 8 will follow the Tuesday schedule with periods 1 and 2.** March 16 is also a school holiday so there will be no Monday schedule for that week.

The following points are important parts of our reopening plan:

- Students returning for in-person instruction should arrive at school between 11:40am and 11:55am and should plan to leave campus by 3:00pm unless they have an extra-curricular activity.
- Students must wear masks while on campus. ([Mask Guidelines](#)). Students should put on their masks as they exit vehicles or enter campus, rather than wait until they are on the main campus. Campus staff and teachers will have extra masks available for students who need one.
- Students who are not scheduled into a PM class are not allowed on campus during school.
- Students will be expected to sanitize their hands when they enter and leave classrooms. Students may bring their own sanitizer or use the sanitizer provided by the school.
- Students will need to bring their charged Chromebooks to school each day.
- Students may bring cleaning wipes to clean their desk and equipment if they choose. Student desks will be sanitized daily.
- The air circulation system will run continuously so classrooms may be cooler than usual. Students should dress appropriately.
- PE students will have access to the locker rooms to change.
- Food Service will have "to-go" meals available daily at 2:45 at the snack bar.
- We will be issuing parking permits during the week of March 8-11. Students will be required to have a parking permit to park on campus starting March 16.
- Parents are asked to screen their students for COVID symptoms daily before sending them to school. ([COVID Symptoms Checklist](#))

We are looking forward to having more of our students on campus and we appreciate your help in following the plan so that we can keep our school open.
